 SUPER FINE	Super Fine, Sock, Fingering, Baby	14 - 30	2.5 – 3.5 mm / B-1 to E-4	1.5 – 2.25 mm / 8 to B-1
 FINE	Fine, Sport, Baby	12 - 18	3.5 – 4.5 mm / medium E-4 to 7	2.25 to 3.0 mm / B-1 to D
 LIGHT	Light, DK, Light Worsted	11 - 15	4.5 – 5.5 mm / 7 to I-9	2.5 to 3.5 mm / C-2 to E-4
 MEDIUM	Medium, Worsted, Afghan, Aran	9 - 12	5.5 – 6.5 mm / I-9 to K-10.5	3.5 to 4.5 mm / E-4 to 7
 BULKY	Bulky, Chunky, Craft, Rug	6 - 9	6.5 - 9 mm / K-10.5 to M-13	5.0 to 6.5 mm / H-8 to K-10 1/2
 SUPER BULKY	Super Bulky, Roving	5 - 6	9 - 15 mm / M-13 to Q	6.0 to 8.0 mm J-10 to L-11
